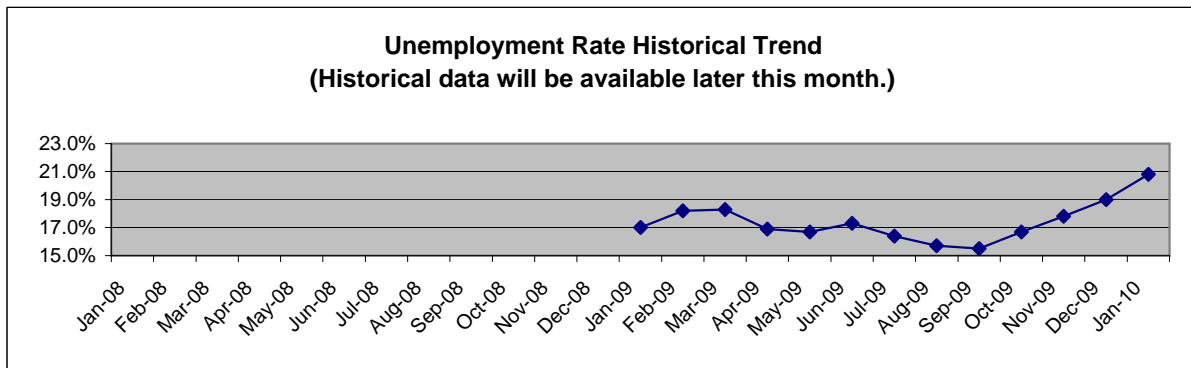


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 YUBA CITY METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Sutter and Yuba Counties)

The unemployment rate in the Yuba City MSA was 20.8 percent in January 2010, up from a revised 19.0 percent in December 2009, and above the year-ago estimate of 17.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 13.2 percent for California and 10.6 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 21.0 percent in Sutter County, and 20.4 percent in Yuba County.
