Narrative

On December 2, 2009 I was contacted by Assistant Chief Barry Roberts with the Springfield Police Department in reference to a complaint of a possible sex offense involving a juvenile that occurred in the county. Upon arrival at the Springfield Police Department I made contact with Suzette ██████████. She stated that on November 25, 2009 she had brought her son, ██████████ (15 years of age), to the Starting Over Straight program in Springfield for a narcotics addiction treatment. She stated that on

Thursday evening she was contacted by SOS staff and advised that [REDACTED] had left the facility. She stated that she was contacted later and advised that [REDACTED] had returned and was found to be in possession of narcotics and all parties would be contacted the following day. Springfield Police were called to the scene and conducted an investigation. Springfield Police Assistant Chief Roberts stated that [REDACTED] was found to be in possession of marijuana and Lorazepam. [REDACTED] first told Springfield Police that he got the narcotics from a dealer down the road but then later recanted and told the officers that he got them from a lady in Crestview, Michelle Kemp. [REDACTED] told the officers that he called a 30 year old woman that is his neighbor in Crestview, later to be identified as Michelle Kemp, and asked her to bring him the drugs. [REDACTED] stated that when Kemp got to SOS he walked out the back door and got into her vehicle. [REDACTED] stated that they drove around the east side of Bay County to a park and Kemp gave him the narcotics. He stated that they then drove to a subdivision which was later discovered to be Shadow Bay and they both got into the back seat of Kemp's SUV. [REDACTED] stated that he and Kemp then had sex. Springfield Police contacted [REDACTED] parents and the Department of Children and Families. A Child Protection Team interview was conducted by the Childrens Advocacy Center. Assistant Chief Roberts made contact with Kemp and she agreed to meet with law enforcement with her attorney on Friday December 4, 2009. Ms. [REDACTED] further stated that she knew Kemp because they were neighbors and that their kids were friends. She stated that Kemp had been investigated a few months ago in Okaloosa County in reference to having oral sex with [REDACTED] but she agreed to drop the charges against Kemp there if Kemp agreed to go to counseling which Kemp did agree to. She stated that she believes Kemp has a problem and did wish to pursue charges in Bay County.

On December 4, 2009 Michelle Kemp came to the Springfield Police Department along with her attorney Michael Gates and met with Assistant Chief Roberts, Sgt. McCroan and myself. Kemp was read her miranda and agreed to talk with us with her attorney present. Kemp stated that she did bring [REDACTED] the narcotics because he asked her to. She stated that they did have sex with [REDACTED] in her vehicle but that it was [REDACTED]'s idea. She stated that when she drove over to Bay County she did not intend to have sex with him. She acknowledged that she knew [REDACTED] was 15 years old and she did have a problem. She stated that she was infatuated with [REDACTED]. Kemp was taken into custody and transported to the Bay County Jail.
