On 10/01/08 at approximately 1923 hrs at 7171 N Davis Hwy in Escambia County, Florida, S/Robert Solariski, did willingly and unlawfully commit the offenses of Driving Under The Influence Of Alcoholic Beverages, Driving A Vehicle With An Open Container Of Alcohol, Leaving The Scene Of An Accident Involving Property Damage, Criminal Mischief, and Resisting An Officer Without Violence.

On 10/01/08 at approximately 1923 hrs I was parked in front of the Bank of America building on Creighton Rd near Davis Hwy. W/Greg Bradley drove a black SUV in front of my patrol car and then exited the vehicle running towards my patrol car. W/Bradley advised me that there was a man driving a tan SUV, ramming cars in the parking lot of Sears. W/Bradley pointed to the vehicle which was parked in the east parking lot of Sears and the vehicle's brake lights were illuminated, which helped W/Bradley point out the vehicle to me. W/Bradley told me he just saw the vehicle pushing one car into another vehicle and then jump the curb and then leave the parking lot. I drove to the location of the vehicle W/Bradley pointed out to me. While driving towards the vehicle, I noticed the driver of the vehicle to be slumped back in the driver's seat and it appeared as if he was passed out. When I pulled behind the vehicle and exited my patrol car, I made contact with W/Joseph Bommarito, who was yelling at me that he saw the man push a car into a truck, while he was pointing at the tan SUV that W/Bradley had identified. I then activated my patrol vehicle's overhead emergency lights and approached the tan-in-color Nissan SUV, bearing Florida tag L228TU, on the driver's side. I identified myself to the driver of the vehicle and asked him to exit the vehicle. The driver was later identified as Robert Solariski. The driver of the vehicle then made a movement towards the gear shifter in the center console of the vehicle as if he was going to drive away. I then opened the driver's door of the vehicle and grabbed S/Solariski's left arm and again ordered him to exit the vehicle. S/Solariski attempted to pull away from me and tried to reach underneath the front passenger seat with his right hand. I gave S/Solariski a very loud verbal order to quit pulling away from me and exit the vehicle, but S/Solariski continued trying to pull away and reach his right hand underneath the front passenger seat. For my safety, I then pulled S/Solariski out of the vehicle by pulling on his left arm. When S/Solariski exited the vehicle, he fell onto the pavement. S/Solariski was then placed in handcuffs. I asked S/Solariski several times to roll to his side so I could pick him up from the pavement. S/Solariski would not cooperate, therefore I was unable to pick him up by myself. I requested back up and when W/Deputy Scott Seely arrived, he helped me pick S/Solariski up off the pavement and place him in the back of my patrol vehicle. While walking S/Solariski to my patrol vehicle, I could smell the odor of alcohol on his breath. I had to order S/Solariski to sit in the rear of my patrol vehicle three times, but he would not comply, therefore I had to physically place him in the back of my patrol vehicle.

I made contact with W/Bradley again who stated while stopped at the intersection of Davis and Creighton he heard the sound of squealing tires. W/Bradley stated he looked at the parking lot located south of Sears Auto Service building and saw an SUV pushing a car into another vehicle. W/Bradley said he then saw the SUV back up and then drive forward, jumping a curb, and driving in circles through the Sears parking lot. W/Bradley said he then noticed me parked across the street from where the incident was occurring and came to me for help. W/Bradley completed a sworn, written statement regarding the incident.

I made contact with W/Bommarito who stated while inside the Sears Auto building, he saw an SUV pushing a car into a truck. W/Bradley said he then watched the SUV while he asked a Sears employee to call the police. W/Bommarito completed a sworn, written statement regarding the incident.

I looked at the front of S/Solariski's vehicle and noticed that there were obvious signs of an accident. W/Bradley then showed me the other vehicles that were involved in the incident. I observed a tan-in-color Acura sedan which had rear and front end damage. The sedan's front end had been pushed into a white in-color Ford truck's front end, which also had front end damage. Behind the sedan I noticed tire marks from where S/Solariski's tires had been spinning on the pavement while he pushed the sedan. V/Paul Pandolfi was the registered owner of the sedan but could not be located at the time of the incident. V/Patti Hurd was the registered owner of the Ford truck but could not be located at the time of the incident. A business card with my name and case number was placed on both victim's vehicles. Crime Scene Technician Wright, #718, responded to the scene to photograph the damage and crime scene. The exact amount of damage could not be determined at this time but, is estimated to be over \$200 worth of damage caused to each of the

victim's vehicles,

OP/PHP Officer Mike Black, #917, responded to the scene and asked S/Solarski if he was willing to perform field sobriety exercises. S/Solarski responded to Officer Black's request by stating, "Fuck no, just arrest me." W/Deputy Seely had spoken with W/Bonmarito and W/Bradley while I was assisting OP/PHP Officer Black and W/Deputy Seely advised OP/PHP Officer Black that S/Solarski had rammed the sedan twice and it appeared to be intentional the second time. Based on that information, OP/PHP Officer Black advised he would not be conducting a traffic crash investigation. W/Deputy Seely made contact with W/Don Muzik, who advised him that he witnessed S/Solarski's SUV pushing an Acura sedan into a Ford Ranger. W/Muzik said S/Solarski's back wheels were spinning and left marks on the pavement. W/Muzik said S/Solarski's vehicle pushed the two vehicles for about five minutes. W/Muzik said he saw S/Solarski's vehicle then back up and drive over a curb and then drive to the parking lot on the east side of the main Sears building. W/Muzik completed a sworn, written statement regarding the incident. S/Solarski had driven his vehicle approximately 200 yards away from the scene of the accident to an entirely different parking lot.

S/Solarski was advised he was being placed under arrest for Leaving The Scene Of An Accident With Property Damage, Resisting An Officer Without Violence, and Criminal Mischief. During a search of S/Solarski's vehicle incident to arrest, W/Deputy Seely discovered a partially consumed bottle of vodka on the rear passenger side floor board of S/Solarski's vehicle.

S/Solarski was transported to Escambia County Jail where OP/Deputy Pool, #216, responded to the jail to assist me in my Driving Under the Influence investigation. Deputy Pool went into the intoxilizer room with S/Solarski. Deputy Pool advised me S/Solarski gave a breath sample and had a BAL of .296 on the first sample and .30 on the second sample. Deputy Pool will complete a supplemental to this report.

A driver's license check revealed that S/Solarski had a valid Florida driver's license. S/Solarski was issued FL DUI UTC 5682-JDK for Driving Under the Influence of Alcoholic Beverages, UTC 7871-FNJ for Driving a Motor Vehicle with an Open Container of Alcohol, and UTC 7872-FNJ for leaving the scene of an accident with property damage. S/Solarski was advised of all of his charges and I completed a DUI Influence report. S/Solarski was scheduled a County Court of 10/22/08 and assessed a \$5000 bond.

A Use of Force Report and Suspect Resistance Form will be completed. My patrol car in-dash camera will be submitted as evidence. S/Solarski sustained an abrasion on his chin and on his right thumb when he fell on the pavement. S/Solarski injuries photographed by CST Wright #718 while at the jail. S/Solarski was treated for his injuries by the jail's medical staff.
