CASE NUMBER FHPA08OFF037143DEFENDANT MOHAMED, JASON, RAFFIQUEADDENDUM OF PROBABLE CAUSE

ON 09/11/08 AT APPROXIMATELY 1:00 A.M., TROOPER CHARLES ALEXANDER WAS DRIVING ON U.S. HIGHWAY 98 (STATE ROAD 30) ON OKALOOSA ISLAND IN OKALOOSA COUNTY, FLORIDA. TROOPER ALEXANDER OBSERVED 2 MALE SUBJECTS IN THE CENTER MEDIAN WITH TWO MOTORCYCLES. WHEN TROOPER ALEXANDER STOPPED TO INVESTIGATE, HE NOTICED A WHITE FEMALE (KARMA RAE THORNTON) LYING IN THE CENTER MEDIAN WITH SEVERE TRAUMA TO HER BODY. AN AMBULANCE WAS CALLED FOR THE INJURED WOMAN AND TROOPER ALEXANDER BEGAN AN INVESTIGATION. THE TWO MEN IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES AS RICARDO REY CASILLAS 10/11/67, AND JASON RAFFIQUE MOHAMED 11/04/79. THE MEN STATED THEY WERE RIDING THEIR MOTORCYCLES WESTBOUND ON U.S. HIGHWAY 98 AND SAW THE VICTIM LYING IN THE MEDIAN. THEY STATED TO TROOPER ALEXANDER THAT THEY DID NOT KNOW WHAT HAD HAPPENED TO THE WOMAN AND DENIED KNOWING WHO SHE WAS. BELIEVING THIS TO BE A HIT-AND-RUN CRASH, TROOPER ALEXANDER GAVE RICARDO CASILLAS AND JASON MOHAMED A WRITTEN STATEMENT FORM. A COPY OF THIS WRITTEN STATEMENT IS ATTACHED. IN IT MR. MOHAMED STATED HE WAS RETURNING FROM DESTIN AND NOTICED A WHITE OBJECT IN THE MEDIAN. HE SAID HE CALLED 911 AND HELD C-SPINE UNTIL EMS ARRIVED. HE STATED HE LATER FOUND OUT WHO THE PATIENT WAS AND THAT HE KNEW HER. MR. MOHAMED SIGNED THE STATEMENT ATTESTING THAT IT WAS TRUE AND ACCURATE. I WAS CALLED TO ASSIST IN THE INVESTIGATION DUE TO THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE INJURIES AND THE COMPLEXITY OF THE INVESTIGATION. WHEN I ARRIVED, I NOTED THERE WAS NO EVIDENCE OF THE VICTIM HAVING BEEN STRUCK BY A VEHICLE. THERE WERE NO CAR PARTS OR BROKEN GLASS IN OR NEAR THE SCENE. I FOUND THIS TO BE UNUSUAL IN A HIGH SPEED VEHICLE VERSUS PEDISTRIAN CRASH. THE VICTIM TUMBLED DOWN THE ROADWAY AND MEDIAN FOR APPROXIMATELY 237 FEET BEFORE COMING TO REST. IT APPEARED TO ME THAT THE VICTIM HAD EITHER FALLEN OFF A MOTORCYCLE OR PICKUP TRUCK, OR WAS THROWN FROM A CAR. THE BOTTOM OF ONE OF THE SHOES HAD A BURN MARK CONSISTENT WITH A MOTORCYCLE'S EXHAUST PIPE. I WENT TO INTERVIEW MR. CASILLAS AT HIS WORK. IN A RECORDED INTERVIEW HE

HE ADMITTED TO HAVING BEEN AT THE BLOCK WITH KARMA THORNTON AND JASON MOHAMED. HE SAID THEY THEN WENT TO HELEN BACK. AFTER THE INTERVIEW, I ASKED HIM IF I COULD LOOK AT HIS MOTORCYCLE. HE SAID YES AND I FOUND BURNED RUBBER ON THE RIGHT EXHAUST PIPE. AT 8:05 PM THAT SAME EVENING CPL. STEPHEN FISHER ATTEMPTED TO INTERVIEW MR. MOHAMED AT THE OCEAN CITY WRIGHT FIRE DEPARTMENT. MR. MOHAMED STATED HE WANTED TO TALK TO AN ATTORNEY AND REFUSED THE INTERVIEW. I OBTAINED A SEARCH WARRANT FOR MR. CASILLAS MOTORCYCLE AND SERVED IT ON 09/12/08. AFTER SERVING THE WARRANT, MR. CASILLAS SAID HE NEEDED TO TALK TO ME. I ASKED HIM WHAT IT WAS ABOUT AND HE BLURTED "SHE WAS ON THE BACK OF MY MOTORCYCLE AND FELL OFF." WHEN I READ HIM HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS HE REFUSED TO ANSWER QUESTIONS. AS I WAS LEAVING, MR CASILLAS SAID THAT IT WAS JASON'S IDEA TO LIE TO THE POLICE. AT 11:30 A.M. THAT SAME DAY I RECEIVED A MESSAGE THAT MR. MOHAMED WANTED TO TALK TO ME. I CALLED MR. MOHAMED AND HE ADVISED ME THAT MR. CASILLAS HAD JUST TOLD HIM THAT KARMA WAS ON HIS MOTORCYCLE AND HAD FALLEN OFF. MR. MOHAMED DENIED ANY PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE OF THE ACCIDENT. HE THEN TYPED A WRITTEN STATEMENT AND GAVE IT TO TROOPER CARY HURST. MR. MOHAMED HAS REPEATEDLY SAID HE DID NOT KNOW THE PATIENT WAS KARMA THORNTON UNTIL AFTER EMS ARRIVED AND TOLD HIM HER NAME. ON 11/04/08 I CONDUCTED A RECORDED SWORN INTERVIEW WITH KARMA THORNTON. SHE STATED SHE HAD BEEN WITH RICARDO AND JASON AT THE BLOCK AND AT HELEN BACK. SHE STATED THEY WENT FOR A RIDE TO DESTIN AND SHE WAS ON RICARDO'S MOTORCYCLE. SHE SAID SHE HAD KNOWN JASON FOR YEARS AND HAD BEEN FRIENDS. SHE ALSO SAID THAT RICARDO AND JASON LEFT THE SCENE AND LEFT HER IN THE MEDIAN FOR A LONG TIME.

IN A SWORN DEPOSITION TAKEN ON 01/28/09, MR. MOHAMED ADMITTED THAT HE HAD KNOWN KARMA THORNTON FOR YEARS. HE ALSO STATED HE HAD BEEN OUT DRINKING WITH MS. THORNTON AND MR. CASILLAS THE NIGHT BEFORE AND THE MORNING OF THE CRASH AND THAT THE THREE OF THEM HAD GONE FOR A MOTORCYCLE RIDE. HE ALSO ADMITTED HE KNEW THAT MS. THORNTON WAS A PASSENGER ON MR. CASILLAS'S MOTORCYCLE.

MR. CASILLAS HAS ALREADY BEEN CHARGED WITH LEAVING THE SCENE OF A CRASH WITH SERIOUS INJURIES AND GIVING FALSE INFORMATION AT A CRASH.
