On May 20th, 2009, at approximately 0738 hours I responded to 1402 Beverly Street #B, Ft. Walton Beach, FL., in reference to a welfare check. Upon arrival contact was made with the reporting person, at which time she stated she could hear a baby crying inside the unit next to her and there appeared to be no one home with the baby.

A more detailed narrative to follow.

On May 20th, 2009, at approximately 0738 hours I responded to 1402 Beverly Street #B, Ft. Walton Beach, FL., in reference to a welfare check. Upon arrival contact was made with the reporting person, Kendra D. Mitchell, at which time the following information was learned. Mitchell stated she got out of her residence at approximately 0730 hours to go to work when she heard a baby, later identified as 7 month old crying in the unit next to where she lived. Mitchell advised she had observed suspect Jennifer M. D'Silva, leave her residence on May 19th, 2009 at approximately 1730 hours without with her. Mitchell was concerned had been left in the residence all night with out care from J. D'Silva because J. D'Silva's vehicle was not in the parking lot or on the grass near the entrance to the residence.

Mitchell stated she attempted to knock on the door of the residence several times to get an adult or someone inside the residence to answer the door but there was no answer. While Mitchell was knocking on the door she could hear crying in the living room area of the residence. When Mitchell could not get anyone to answer the door and could not hear if anyone was inside the residence she called the Sheriff's Office.

I Knocked on the door several times and also could hear crying in the living room area of the residence. There was a window next to the front door to the residence but I was unable to see into the residence to see if anyone was inside with . I checked the window and the front door and they were both locked. I spent approximately 15 minutes trying to see inside th residence and to hear any movement inside the residence but the only thing I could hear was crying and could not see inside the residence. I then contacted Cpl. Hafner in reference to the situation, at which time I was advised to contact Communications and the Fire Department to obtain an emergency contact number for the apartment complex. The complex was under Progressive Management and there was not an emergency contact number listed with Communications or the Fire Department. I spoke with the male neighbor who was exiting the residence above J. D'Silva's residence and he stated he only saw her from time to time and did not know any information about her.

Cpl. Hafner and I attempted to see in the other windows leading into the bedrooms but they were closed and locked as well. We could not smell any odors emitting from the residence from where we were located outside the residence. There was a trash can just outside the front door with several baby diapers inside the can. Just west of the front door was a door for the laundry room. The laundry room was unlocked so I opened it and

observed two trash bags with old dirty diapers, trash, and bugs on the ground. There was a strong odor of fecal matter and decay emitting from the trash bags and the laundry room. Cpl. Hafner and I attempted several times to make contact with someone inside the residence but there was no answer and only crying.

I then contacted an employee of Progressive Management and she made contact with the Property Manager of the apartment; [redacted] was in. The property Manager, Darinda L. Blankenship, was notified of the situation, at which time she came to the apartment complex with a key. Blankenship arrived on scene with her other Property Manager, Megan M. Mcgoldrick. Blankenship knocked on the door and announced herself as management for the property. After a few moments of no noise, other than crying, or any acknowledgement she opened the front door with a key.

Once the front door was opened a strong odor of fecal matter and decay emitted from the interior of the residence while we were still standing outside the residence. With the door open while standing outside the residence I observed [redacted] lying strapped in a car seat with no top on and only a bed sheet covering half of her torso. It was later discovered [redacted] was wearing a soiled diaper. The car seat was on the floor in front of the t.v. with [redacted] facing the south wall of the residence and her back facing the wall next to the front door (north wall of the residence). All around [redacted] on the floor were old dirty diapers with fecal matter in them and some of them had several gnats in and around them. There were trash, clothing, empty medical ointment containers for rashes, and dirty diaper wipes on the floor around [redacted] and through out the residence. The baby also had two bottles of formula on the floor on either side of the car seat directly next to the car seat with formula still in the bottles. [redacted] had a tan in color sheet covering her torso and legs but the sheet had what appeared to be a blood stain on it. Cpl. Hafner and I announced ourselves as law enforcement but there was no movement or noise within the residence other than crying. I then cleared the residence for safety and concluded there was no one inside the residence with [redacted]

The whole residence was in complete disarray with clothing and trash all over the floor, counter tops, table tops, in the bed rooms, and bath rooms. The baby's room had a crib in it up against one of the walls. In the crib were small piles of food and stains on the bedding that had not been cleaned up. In the master bedroom there was a baby bassinet crib with clothing and cloths hangers in it and on it. There were bloody feminine pads on the floor in the master bedroom along with other hygiene products on the floor.

Deputy Brake and Sgt. Keller-Lithgow arrived on scene, at which time Deputy Brake began conducting the crime scene investigation photographs. I called the information obtained into the Abuse Hot line and reported the incident. I spoke with intake call taker, Jennifer ID number 5711, and provided her with the information obtained. A report was generated and forwarded to the Department of Children and Family Services (DCF), at which time Investigator Henderson responded to the incident location for the report. After photographs were taken of the scene Sgt. Keller-Lithgow lifted the sheet off of the baby and observed several large urine stains in the sheet where [redacted] had been on top of it. The car seat [redacted] was in was soaked in urine that could not be contained in the diaper. [redacted] was removed from the car seat by Sgt. Keller-Lithgow, at which time Deputy Brake took photographs of the baby's back. [redacted] had a red mark that covered the back of her [redacted]

legs and back, this was the area in contact with the urine soaked car seat padding. The diaper was filthy and had fecal stains around the leg areas of the diaper. Sgt. Keller-Lithgow then took the diaper off to change [redacted], at which time it was observed the baby had fecal matter in her vaginal area and buttocks area. [redacted] had a rash on her vaginal area, legs, and buttocks. The rash near the vaginal area appeared to be blisters some of which were open. After Sgt. Keller-Lithgow cleaned [redacted] and applied a new diaper on her it was observed the baby had a bruise on the bridge of her nose. It was unknown how this bruise occurred. Inv. Henderson took [redacted] to the Child Advocacy Center (CAC) for further investigation.

I spoke with Mitchell and obtained a sworn written affidavit of complaint from her. Mitchell stated she had been suspicious of J. D'Silva because every time she would see J. D'Silva coming home or leaving home she would not have the baby with her. Mitchell stated she would hear the baby in the residence from time to time but was unsure if anyone was present caring for the baby. Mitchell stated on May 16th, 2009 at approximately 1130 hours she came out of her residence, directly next to J. D'Silva's, and heard the baby crying inside. Mitchell thought someone was there caring for the baby but became concerned when she observed J. D'Silva's vehicle was not in the parking lot or on the grassy area directly in front of J. D'Silva's residence. Mitchell stated J. D'Silva returned home at approximately 1330 hours on May 16th, 2009, two hours later, and was acting strange after she saw her. Mitchell did not see anyone enter or leave the residence who appeared to have been caring for

Mitchell then began to watch D'Silva's residence and listen for the baby in the residence. Mitchell stated she had not seen the baby for a few months because D'Silva never had the baby with her when she came home or left the residence but she could hear the baby inside the residence. Mitchell stated she did not know anything about J. D'Silva because they only said "Hi" or "Bye" as they passed each other but did not interact with each other in any other way. Mitchell stated J. D'Silva has never asked her to watch the baby for her and did not appear to have anyone caring for [redacted] while she was gone.

From the time the call came into Communications at approximately 0729 hours until the investigation was completed on scene at approximately 1000 hours J. D'Silva had not returned to the residence. I left a card on J. D'Silva's door for her to contact me through Communications.

Upon arriving at the Shalimar Courthouse Annex to complete the paperwork for the investigation I was informed by Sgt. Keller-Lithgow that [redacted] was having a medical exam at the CAC at approximately 1230 hours. I then made contact with Inv. Henderson and she stated Dr. Keefe was the doctor who was going to do the medical exam on [redacted] Inv. Henderson also stated at approximately 1030 hours [redacted] was given approximately 12 ounces of formula, at which time she drank it all and was still hungry for more.

I then received a telephone call from Inv. Lisa Lydston, supervisor for DCF, advising J. D'Silva was on the phone with her case worker through DCF. J. D'Silva was being evasive with the case worker and would not tell them where she was at or provide any other information. J. D'Silva only asked the case worker if she was going to be arrested and did not ask about the condition of [redacted] It was unknown if J. D'Silva had returned to the

residence or if she knew _____ was in DCF custody.

Contact was made with Inv. Henderson in reference to the results to the medical examination of E. D'Silva by Dr. Keefe. Per Inv. Henderson Dr. Keefe found medical negligence in the case of the baby's injuries. It had been found _____ had a misshapen head due to being in the car seat for extended periods of time and a weak muscular structure caused by lack of physical mobility or interaction. The muscular issues require physical therapy and the misshapen head could be treated. _____ also had a yeast infection caused by the urine burns and fecal matter. Inv. Henderson also asked Dr. Keefe if the injuries could be a result of _____ being in the car seat since 1730 hours the night before and it was stated that the urine burns on the babies back could have been due to being in the car seat since 1730 hours the night before. The infection requires prescribed ointment for treatment. Dr. Keefe will be completing a report of the examination and will submit it for the case file.

At this time it is unknown where J. D'Silva is located or who she is with. Based on J. D'Silva being evasive with her caseworker and not providing any information in reference to where she is located. A warrant will be applied for her arrest.

Case status: Active Pending Warrant.

On May 20th, 2009, I completed the warrant package at which time it was reviewed and approved, signed by Judge Grinsted. The warrant for J. D'Silva was active prior to the end of my shift.

On May 21st, 2009, at approximately 1145 hours I responded to the Department of Children And Families office on Beal Pkwy, Ft. Walton Beach, FL., in reference to a follow up investigation. Upon arrival contact was made with Inv. Henderson at which time she provided me with a copy of J. D'Silva's Myspace account photographs and comments. Inv. Henderson stated the account was accessed by _____

The photographs obtained show J. D'Silva dressed up and at different locations that appeared to be either clubs or parties. In several of the photographs J. D'Silva appeared to be holding alcoholic beverages and she was under age, J. D'Silva is 20 years old as of today's date. One of the photographs had J. D'Silva dressed up with another female and she appeared to be "hanging out" with the comment of "10-18-08" under the picture.

_____ just 16 days before the picture was supposedly taken.

There were also several comments left in the Myspace profile from J. D'Silva from the dates of April 24th, 2009 until May 19th, 2009. Several of the comments reference going out to different clubs, going to get her nails done, going to the gym, going to work, and going shopping. The following are some of the comments, the dates, and the times:

"Tanning" at 9:54 A.M. April 25th, 2009
"Almost off work then dinner at Justins" at 3:07 P.M. April 29th, 2009
"Going to J'Ville" 2:10 P.M. May 2nd, 2009
"Drinking then out to Flyleaf then Helenbackkk" at 7:28 P.M. May 6th, 2009
"Alabama with my bestie" at 12:55 P.M. May 7th, 2009
"With Farren" at 12:09 A.M. May 13th, 2009
"Seville tonight" at 1:22 P.M. May 14th, 2009
"Seville tonight with Farren and Kelly" at 8:14 P.M. May 14th, 2009
"Being lazy until I have to go to work....noooo :(someone take my shift =)" at 12:20 P.M. May 15th, 2009
"Work" at 4:03 P.M. May 15th, 2009
"Bored at work :(aqua tonight" at 4:31 P.M. May 15th, 2009
"Tonight was lame :(text me 5857744" at 12:34 A.M. May 16th, 2009
"Boating" at 12:51 P.M. May 16th, 2009
"Had a fun weekend :)" at 10:31 A.M. May 17th, 2009

There were several other comments along with the ones listed above. The comment talking about going to work and then to Aqua, Aqua is a club in Destin, was the night the reporting person, Mitchell, stated she observed J. D'Silva dressed up at approximately 2200 hours leaving her residence with a male waiting in her vehicle. Mitchell did not see J. D'Silva with _____ and did not see or hear a baby sitter with _____

The comment about boating was at approximately 1251 hours on May 16th, 2009 was also the day Mitchell stated she heard the baby crying inside J. D'Silva's residence at approximately 1130 hours. Mitchell further stated J. D'Silva returned home at approximately 1330 hours and was acting "hesitant" to go inside her own residence until Mitchell herself entered her own residence.

After obtaining these documents from Inv. Henderson I observed a picture of a female and the comment stating her name was "Farren" and that she was J. D'Silva's "lover". I was familiar with Farren from previous cases I have worked and identified her as being Farren Small. Small had an address in the Master Name Index of 88 Spinnaker Lane in Shalimar. Sgt. Keller-Lithgow then went to 88 Spinnaker Lane and observed a vehicle matching the description of J. D'Silva's vehicle in the drive way. After further investigation it was determined the address was Small's address so Inv. Watkins and Inv. Merchant observed the residence until contact was made with J. D'Silva and she was arrested for the active warrant.

Investigators Watkins and Merchant transported J. D'Silva to the Shalimar Courthouse Annex where I made contact with her while being processed through booking. I asked J. D'Silva if she would be willing to talk about the case. J. D'Silva stated she would need to consult her lawyer first. No further questions were asked about the case and she was not read her Miranda Rights due to her refusal to talk. D/S Frank Allen was present when I asked J. D'Silva if she would talk about the case and when she asked for a lawyer. A Your Rights form was signed by me and witnessed by D/S Frank Allen and was entered into the case file.

The Myspace documentation was entered into evidence and a copy was entered into the case file. A copy of J. D'Silva's finger print cards were entered into evidence.
