JobsPlus One Stop Centers in Fort Walton Beach, Crestview, and DeFuniak Springs are currently accepting applications for 200 positions in Okaloosa County and 200 positions in Walton County for possible beach cleanup from the oil spill. These positions are for employment with a private-sector company that has a contract with BP.

Individuals will be hired for three different positions paying \$18.00, \$20.00 and \$32.00 per hour. Approximately 20 of the 200 positions will be hired as a Level III which will require supervisory experience. All candidates will undergo drug testing and a background check for the past five years. Information needed for I-9's will be required. Selected candidates will be paid for completion of the required number of hours of training that will range from four for a Level I to 40 hours of training for Level III. Once training is complete, additional paid employment will depend on **if and when** oil comes ashore on the beaches of Okaloosa and/or Walton Counties. Applicants must be residents of the County in which they are applying.

Applications may be completed on-site or completed off site and returned to JobsPlus. First priority for applicants will be unemployed residents of Okaloosa and Walton Counties.
